These things are gradually removed so that the children can achieve things on their own.

It helps them to choose a book that matches their current reading attainment. #### Safeguarding


Safer Internet Day 2023 takes place on Tuesday 7th February and is centred around conversations with its theme 'Want to talk about it?'


